## Statutory policies for maintained school Governing Boards

Governing bodies of maintained schools **must** have policies on:

- admissions arrangements <u>school admissions code</u>
- behaviour and written statement of principles <u>keeping children safe in</u>
  <u>education and behaviour and discipline in schools: guide for governing bodies</u>
- careers guidance careers guidance for education providers
- charging and remissions <u>charging for school activities</u>
- data protection privacy notice <u>data protection: privacy notice model</u> <u>documents</u>
- equality objectives Equality Act 2010: advice for schools
- governors' allowances see part 6 of our guidance on School governance regulations 2013
- health and safety <u>health and safety advice for schools</u>
- premises management good estate management for schools
- relationships and sex education and health education relationships and sex education and health education
- safeguarding and child protection keeping children safe in education
- school attendance working together to improve school attendance
- school complaints school complaints: guidance for maintained schools
- school exclusions school suspensions and permanent exclusions
- school uniforms <u>developing and implementing a school uniform</u> policy and <u>cost of school uniforms</u>
- special educational needs and disability SEND code of practice: 0 to 25 years
- staff behaviour and grievance <u>staffing and employment: advice for schools and keeping children safe in education</u>

## Review cycle

It is recommended that governing bodies review these policies annually. This is with the exception of the equality objectives policy which can be reviewed every 4 years.
